

AGREEMENT ON THE DUAL MASTER DEGREE PROGRAM

Between

DAEGU NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF EDUCATION

And

NATIONAL PINGTUNG UNIVERSITY

Based on the “Memorandum of Understanding between Daegu National University of Education and National Pingtung University”, both Universities agree to implement a dual master degree program (hereinafter referred to as “the Program”) under the following conditions in order to strengthen their mutually friendly relationship and further promote academic exchanges.

1. Definitions

The definitions of the terms in this agreement shall be as follows.

Home university: the university in which the students are enrolled in their own country.

Host university: the university in which the students study abroad.

2. Degree Conferral

Upon successfully completing the Program, participating students who meet graduation requirements for this Program will be conferred an accredited Master degree from DNUE, Korea and an accredited Master degree from NPTU, Taiwan.

3. Number of Students Accepted

A small number of students shall be accepted each academic year and every effort shall be made to maintain a balance in number between the universities as much as possible.

4. Application Procedure

- a. Applicants should first contact the home university expressing their intention together with 2 copies of applications, 2 copies of transcripts, certificate of student status letter, language proficiency certificate, study plan and interested field of study.
- b. The applications should be passed to the office of International Affairs of home university.
- c. All the application materials should reach the Office of the International Affairs of the host university before the end of February or the end of September for starting the Program in Fall semester or Spring semester, respectively.

5. Selection Process

- a. Phase I: The home department will select the qualified students based on their academic performance and relevant documents.
- b. Phase II: The host university will assess the applications and notify the result.

6. Length of Study

Students should stay at least 2 semesters (at least 8 months) at each university.

7. Thesis Supervision

The students of the Program will conduct appropriate thesis research at both related departments. The supervision of project and thesis work will be resolved through the consultation between faculty members from both universities. The related details are described in the subsequent agreement.

8. Credit Transfer and Acceptance

Both universities have the rights to determine whether the courses that the participating students taken at both universities will be granted or not.

9. Matriculation, Registration for Courses, and Grading

- a. The process of matriculation and registration for courses, and grading shall conform to the academic policies of both institutions.
- b. The host department is responsible for advising students in course registration. An official transcript from the host university must be received by the home university upon successful completion of the semester.

10. Tuition and Fees

- a. Students of this Program are responsible for paying tuition fees to their home university. Tuition fees are waived at the host university.
- b. Students of this Program don't have to pay credit fees at host University.
- c. Any other fees at the host university are paid by students of this Program.

11. Accommodation and Scholarship

Both universities shall endeavor to ensure dormitory and scholarship for the students.

12. Health and Injury Insurance Policy

Students of this Program are required to purchase health and injury insurance.

13. Details of Implementation


The specific details for implementation of the Program based on this agreement shall be stipulated separately through consultation between the two institutions of both universities.

14. Effectiveness, Modification and Termination

This agreement shall take effect on the date of final signature and may be terminated according to the same terms set forth in Memorandum of Understanding between DNUE and NPTU. If either university intends to terminate or to modify the agreement, a written notice should be given to the other university six(6) months prior to the desired effective date of termination.


